



## **Minnesota State University-Mankato Transfer Policy**

### **Transfer Admission**

Transfer applicants with a minimum of 24 semester (36 quarter) college level credit hours, from regionally accredited colleges or universities, having completed at least 67 per cent of credits attempted with a cumulative grade-point average of 2.00 ("A"=4.0), will generally be admitted to Minnesota State Mankato with advanced standing.

Transfer applicants who have NOT completed 24 semester (36 quarter) college level credit hours must meet the high school graduate admission requirements described previously and must have achieved a cumulative grade-point average of 2.00 and a 67 percent completion rate on college-level credit.

Transfer applicants from colleges and universities NOT regionally accredited may be considered for admission on an individual basis. Admission, if granted, will not necessarily be with advanced standing. Transfer applicants under academic or disciplinary suspension or dishonorably dismissed from previous institutions or who are unable to obtain official transcripts will not be considered for admission.

All transcripts of courses taken from all post-secondary institutions must be sent to the Office of Admissions.

### **Application Deadlines.**

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis, but to expedite processing, it is recommended that applications be received 45 days before a semester begins. Applications for admission will not be considered complete until all required materials and processing fees are received in the Admissions office. Materials submitted to the Office of Admissions become the property of Minnesota State Mankato and will not be returned. Applications must be completed five (5) working days prior to the start of classes to be considered.
